1. What are you thankful for / what do you have to praise God for this week?
 2. What has been a struggle / what do you need prayer for this week?
 3. What were your “I will _____” statements from last week? How did you do on them?
 4. Pray for one another.
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DISCOVER

Read 1 Corinthians 15:30-58

In this passage, the Apostle Paul challenges the thinking that this earthly life is all there is and that there is nothing beyond this life.

1. What does this passage teach us about God? What is God’s desire for His children in terms of our eternal destiny? How does God feel about human death?
2. What does this passage tell you about human beings? What does it mean to live with the philosophy, “Let’s feast and drink for tomorrow we die!”? What does God think about that philosophy?
3. What does this passage teach about life, death and the afterlife? In light of that teaching how should we then live (v. 58)?

Practical Reflections:

4. If you were convinced that the grave was NOT your ultimate destiny, how would that change some of your choices?
 5. If you were convinced that God saw the big picture of your life better than you, how would you follow Him differently? Be as specific as you can.
 6. What does it mean that our physical bodies can’t inherit the Kingdom of God? Does that also include our physical treasures? How can you invest your physical body and treasure you can’t take with you, to create an inheritance that you can?
 7. What does it mean for you personally to live in the hope of your promised resurrection?
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PRAY AND RESPOND

1. What is God calling you to do in response to this passage?
2. What is your “I will” statement? (Example: “I will take a step of faith by _____.”)

3. Who will you share your “I will” statement with this week for accountability?

4. How can others pray for you?

Mission Focus:

- Who will you bless this week?
- How will you live on mission this week?

Spend time praying for each other. Each person should check in with at least one other person from the group this week to pray for and encourage them in their “I will” statement.
