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DISCOVER

Read Galatians 4:19, 2 Corinthians 2:16-18 & 1 John 3:2

This verse describes what God wants to accomplish in your life through a process He calls discipleship. Reas the supporting passages and consider what it means to have Christ fully developed in you.

Supporting Passages:

2 Corinthians 2:16-18, 1 John 3:2

Discussion Questions:

1. The first step of discipleship is the Faith commitment. What does that involve? (1 Corinthians 15:1-4)
 2. The next commitment is the Baptism Commitment. Why is that so hard for some people? Have you made the Faith and Baptism Commitments?
 3. The next commitment is the commitment to the Body of Christ. What kinds of things does that commitment involve? How are you doing on that commitment? What is the Spirit asking you to do?
 4. The final Commitment is the Mission Commitment to the work of Christ in the world. What kinds of things does that commitment involve?
 5. The Mission commitment involves sacrifice expressed through generosity with our Time, Talents (spiritual gifts) and Treasure. What kind of generosity does God ask for with our time? With our talents? With our treasures? What is the next step for you?

1. What is God calling you to do in response to this passage?
2. What is your "I will" statement? (Example: "I will take a step of faith by _____.")
3. Who will you share your "I will" statement with this week for accountability?

4. How can others pray for you?
