1. What were your “I Will _____” statements from last week? How did you do on them? What are you encouraged about? What challenges are you facing? How can your group help?
2. Can you think of a time when something you thought was a disaster turned out to be one of the best things that ever happened to you? Describe the event. What did God save you from?
3. Read Luke 4:14-30 in a couple of translations. Restate it in your own words. What does this teach you about God? About human nature? About you?
4. What were the expectations of the people when Jesus entered his home town? When Jesus finished reading the scroll, what did the people think about Him (v. 22)? How were they then feeling in verses 28-30? Have you ever had days like that?
5. What does verse 14 say about Jesus, what He would do and what He would say? What does Isaiah 7:14 say about Him? Some pray expecting Jesus to do what they want; others pray expecting to find out what Jesus wants THEM to do. Which is more correct? How do you pray?
6. Read Isaiah 55:8-9. What does this say about God? How might this explain our confusion when Jesus acts differently from the way we expect? How can we set our expectations on Jesus better?
7. Why do we feel wronged when Jesus makes decisions that affect us negatively? What is our expectation of Jesus when that happens. If Jesus is our King, what should our response be?
8. What should I do in response to this passage? How will you complete the sentence, “I will _____”? Who will you share your “I Will” statement with? How can others pray for you?
